How to book onto SIL Online TEAMS Sessions

Thank you for continuing to engage with our online training this term as we moved from Zoom to TEAMS.

As a response to feedback, I have put together the following steps to support you to access our online training as easily as possible:

- First, go to our website <https://www.schoolimprovementliverpool.co.uk/Training> and book a place on your chosen training to secure a place (choose **Schools outside Liverpool**) Please note, this only secures your place on the session, it does not mean you are registered for the TEAMS session, please follow the next steps below.
- Once you have booked onto the training, you will receive a booking confirmation email. Within this confirmation email there will be a link to register for the TEAMS session. If your booking confirmation does not have a TEAMS link, please don't worry as a day before the training, you will receive an email from EDNet@si.liverpool.gov.uk with a reminder to register.

- Once you have clicked on the TEAMS link in the email, you will be asked to register and you will need to type in your first name, surname, email address and organisation. **Once you have clicked 'register', you will receive a further email approximately 3 minutes later to the email address you have just typed in on the registration page for TEAMS. Please keep an eye on your junk or clutter folder.** Once you have received this email, there will be a link to join the session. Please click on 'join' and you will be prompted to access the training via the Teams App or web browser.

If you have registered for the Teams session an hour before, you will also receive an automated email reminder with the joining link too.

Please note, if you have set up one email address for all staff to attend training, or staff use their school email addresses or personal ones, the TEAMS link will be sent to the email address added when registering.
